3 Use RMC as commandline-tool

```
java -jar RMC.jar [-<options>] [<source-directory>] [<destination-directory>]
```

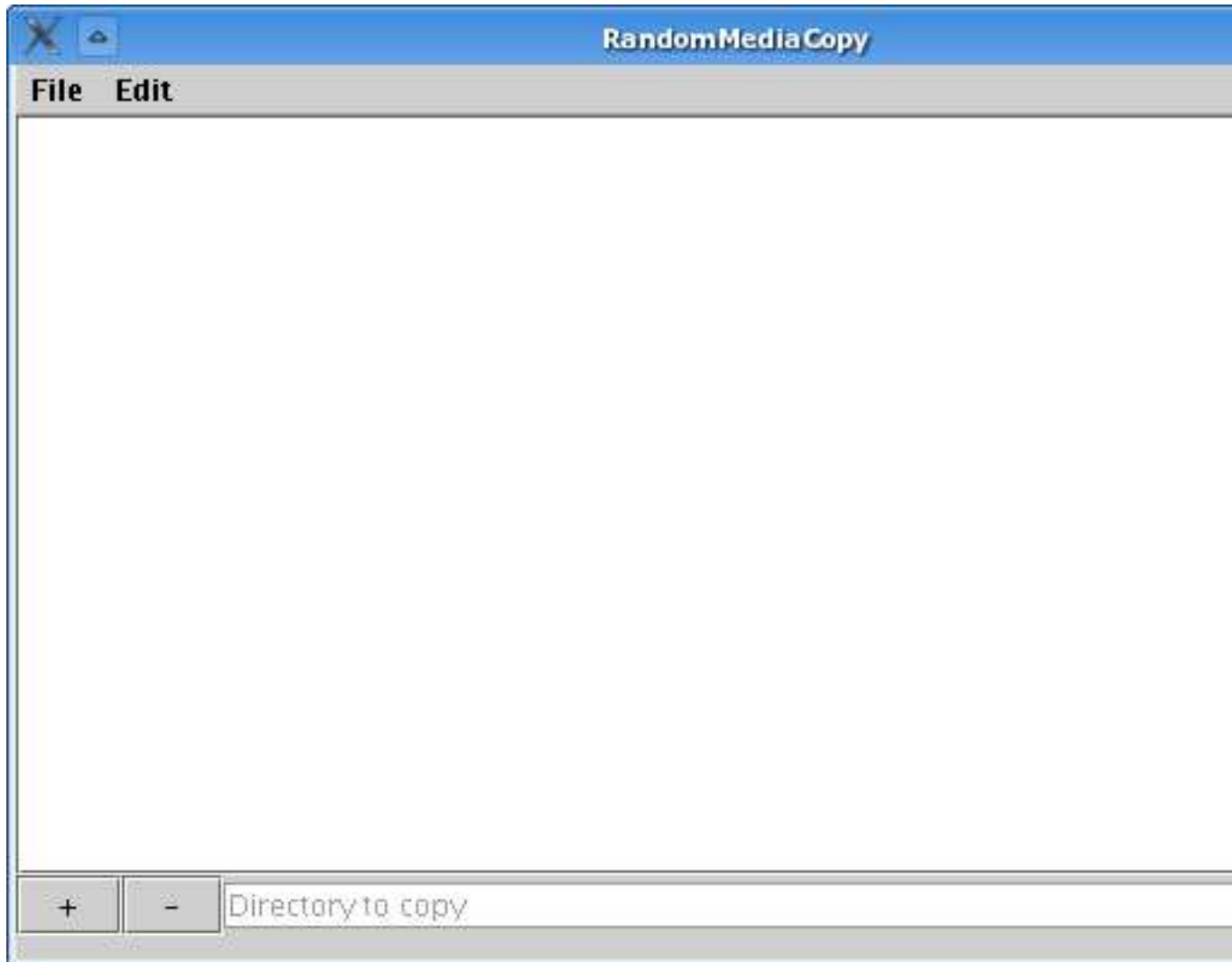
